How to prepare for each Confirmation Session:

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| 10/1 | Wear warm clothes and comfortable shoes - we may be walking. |
| 10/8 | Prepare a response to this question: If someone asked you to define or describe what it means to be a Christian, what would you tell them? |
| 10/15 | Bring version 1 of your story of faith. |
| 10/15-1/21 | We will study the Bible in 12 stories. To prepare for each, <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read over this week's pages in your sketch journal.• Try at least one of the Explore More options from last week.• If you want to go all Super-Confo, listen to this week's audio on our website BEFORE we meet so you can already formulate some good thoughts and questions on this week's story. |
| 2/11 | Bring your completed story of faith and be ready to share it with the group. |
| 2/25 | Make a list of the talents, skills, abilities, and resources God has given you. Make a 2 nd list of how you might be able to utilize those things to serve God in your everyday life and to help Falling Spring Church become even better! |
| 2/25 | Church membership applications due. |
| 3/4 | Session meeting on Monday evening. Bring your story of faith and make sure you know what your favorite Scripture is and why. |
