DIRECTIONS TO FALLING SPRING HORSE VALLEY ACRES:

Families are responsible for transportation to and from camp. Campers are not permitted to have a vehicle at camp.

- From the intersection of Rt. 11 and 997, take 997 N to red light at Letterkenny Gate 6 (5-way intersection)
- Continue N on 997 for 4.0 miles.
- Turn Left onto 533 W (its 2.8 miles to Upper Strasburg). Continue straight up and over the mountain.
- Cross the hump-back bridge and continue 0.9 miles and turn left onto Upper Horse Valley Road.
- Go 1.4 miles and turn left onto Keefer Road/Bear Valley
- Go 0.1 mile and turn right onto Stone House Lane.
- Enter gate and go 0.2 miles to Stone house and pavilion on left.

LEADERS

CFS is staffed with excellent leaders! Each cabin is staffed by at least two counselors, who are thoughtfully selected. Additionally, we have an amazing God Squad (food team), Log Squad (logistics), and medical team. From all our leaders, we require current PA Child Abuse History clearances, PA Criminal Background Checks for staff, and FBI criminal background check (for leaders who moved to PA in the past 10 years).

CAMP RULES

Rules	Why?
Follow the schedule and be on time.	So you don't miss the fun, and so we know you didn't get eaten by a bear.
No alcohol, tobacco, drugs, weapons, or explosives.	To keep everyone safe. If the bears find out you brought these, they will eat you.
Please respect Horse Valley and the properties donated for camp. Please keep cabins clean and well cared for. Also, we are not permitted in cabins not in use for camp. Only the cabins listed may be visited.	Out of gratitude and respect for the generous people who lend us their property, and so we can keep coming back. Also, disrespect angers the bears, and we do NOT want to anger the bears!
Stay at your cabin after the evening event and before wake up. You may not leave your cabin at night unless a staff member is with you.	To keep everyone safe. I don't even want to mention what the bears will do if you try to sneak out.
Do not enter any cabin of campers of the opposite sex for any reason.	Bears despise this, and they will eat you.
No cell phones or electronic entertainment devices.	Seriously, we all need a break from these. These devices agitate the bears and make them very hungry.
Do not leave Horse Valley until camp is over.	Camp is best and you are safest when we are all together. And there are hungry bears hiding at every exit!
Obey our canoeing and swimming rules. Take enough life jackets for each person in the canoe. No more than 3 campers in one canoe at a time. No paddling upstream.	The lake rules have been developed for your safety. If that doesn't convince you, please understand the bears have specialized scuba equipment.
Campers are not permitted in the Stone House unless for first aid or programming.	This gives our God Squad the necessary space to feed everyone. The bears always side with the God Squad!
Visitors to camp are not permitted in the cabins.	This keeps everyone and their belongings safe. The bears have been given a camp list - they will eat any unauthorized visitors.
