

## **Falling Spring Presbyterian Church Summer Youth Ministry Internship**

Duration: 10 weeks (Full-time)

Location: Falling Spring Presbyterian Church

Compensation: Stipend of \$3,500

Supervisor: Director of Youth Ministry

### **Position Overview**

The summer youth ministry internship is a 10-week ministry experience designed to develop young leaders who are passionate about serving teenagers and growing in their relationship with Jesus.

The intern will gain hands-on ministry experience by leading youth Sunday school, helping plan and lead summer youth group gathering, and serving as a key leader during a week of summer camp (Camp Falling Spring).

This internship is an opportunity to explore working in ministry, strengthen leadership skills, and grow in faith while making a meaningful impact in the lives of middle and high school students.

### **Core Responsibilities**

1. Teaching & Discipleship
  - Help teach weekly youth Sunday school lessons
  - Model Christ-centered living and relational ministry in all settings
  - Lead small group discussions that encourage spiritual growth and community among youth
  - Teach a morning session at Camp (If skilled in public speaking & desires to do so)
2. Event Leadership & Youth Events
  - Assist in planning, promoting, and leading weekly youth group events and summer gatherings that focus on community & relationships among youth
  - Lead games, activities, and interactive elements that help create a welcoming, fun and faith-filled environment
  - Build relationships with youth through intentional presence, mentoring, and conversations
3. Camp
  - Serve in a key role during summer camp week- planning & leading games, small group times, creative elements, cabin time
  - Support camp logistics as needed- preparation, packing, communication, set-up, tear-down, schedule keeping
4. Ministry Support & Team Collaboration
  - Work closely with the Director of Youth Ministry and the CFS planning committee to plan, evaluate and execute summer programming
  - Assist with communication, social media updates, and other ministry logistics as needed
  - Attend weekly staff meetings, planning sessions, and debrief gatherings as scheduled
5. Personal & Spiritual Growth

- Commit to regular personal devotional time and prayer
- Participate in mentoring meetings with the Director of Youth Ministry for reflection and growth
- Demonstrate humility, teachability, and a willingness to serve in all aspects of ministry life

### **Qualifications**

- A growing personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Passion for youth ministry and helping youth grow in their faith
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Dependable, flexible, and willing to serve in a team environment
- Comfortable leading games and small group discussions
- Minimum age: 1 year out of high school
- Prior experience with youth ministry or summer camp is helpful but not required

### **Schedule & Commitment**

- Includes evenings and weekend hours for youth events and camp
- Must be available for the full duration of the internship
